## GOODBYE

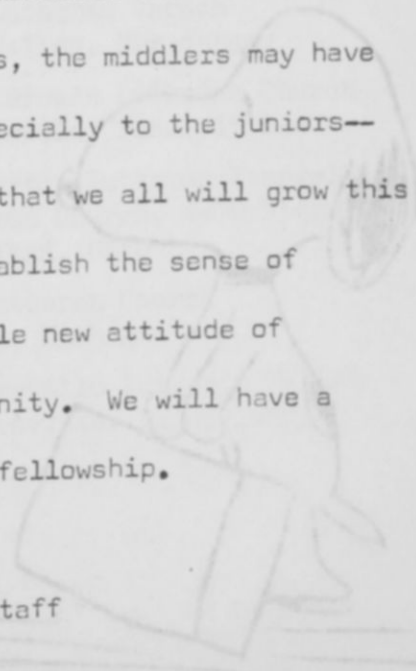
TO ALL STUDENTS:
