
Please help me. I want to do what is right. If I can't find the Lutheran position must I remain virgin all my life? Desparately yours,

OLSON LEADS HOOPLAERS OVER WESTMIN.


The Mt. Airy Saints, led by their rookie center dick "the popper" Olson, rolled over Westminster Seminary on the opponent's court Monday night, 77-64.

The Saints started out a little shaky, getting the range, and trailed Westmin by 23-19 at the end of the first quarter. They came back to take over the lead in the second quarter however, led by Olson and Arnie "the dream" Holtberg to take a 38-35 half-time lead into the locker room.

In the third quarter the Saints busted the game wide open, outscoring Westminster 23 to 14 and lead the "giants" 61-49 at the end of the period. It was the tenacious man-to-man defense deplored by the Saints that broke the game in their favor. Holtberg made the first bucket of the fourth period and the Saints were never pressured. Holtberg and Gerhard did a magnificent job on the 6' 10" monster, Rowe, holding him to a mere 35 points. He was the high scorer for the game. Olson led the Saints in scoring with 24, followed by Holtberg who tickled the cords for 18 big points.
